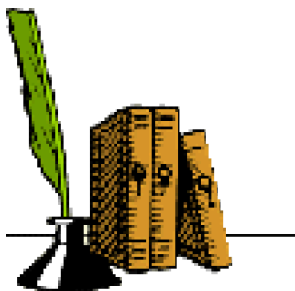


## ***ROOPA'S TESTIMONY!***
