<u>Isaiah 40:31</u> But they that <u>wait</u> upon the LORD shall {renew: Heb. change} their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

"Wait" #6960 = A verb (action); probable origin twist, stretch, then of tension of enduring, waiting: strong, strength, also **strand of rope**; endure, remain, await, threads, so spiders web. those waiting for, **Unity**!

<u>Psalms 40:1</u> «To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David.» I waited <6960> patiently <6960> for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and **heard** my cry (action).

<u>Isaiah 49:23</u> And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with their face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: **for they shall not be ashamed that wait <6960> for me.** 





## **Ecclesiastes 4:8-12**
