

The Sensation of Fear

The sensation of fear is a neurotic experience. A person suffering fear is sick. Fear creates feelings of helplessness and failure, incompetence and worthlessness.



It paralyzes one's capabilities and powers, and generates hatred for the person or thing feared - "Sinners in Zion were afraid." Fear is also closely bound up with a feeling of guilt. As observed, it is really madness.



The Torah described the sensation in clear terms to which no modern psychiatrist can add anything!! ***And among these nations shalt thou find no ease, and there shall be no rest for the sole of thy foot: but the LORD shall give thee there a trembling heart, and failing of eyes, and pining of soul: and thy life shall hang in doubt before thee; and thou shalt fear night and day, and shalt have none assurance of thy life: in the morning thou shalt say, Would God it were even! and at even thou shalt say, Would God it were morning! for the fear of thine heart which thou shalt fear, and for the sight of thine eyes which thou shalt see.*** Deuteronomy 28:65-67
